Behaviour Management


- Students are given 'Praise Cards' from teachers for effort during lesson time
- Teachers fill out end of month reports to monitor progression and assessments
- Students are given 'Behaviour Reflection Time' in the form of tasks around the house for their lack of effort and poor behaviour this is monitored by parents/carers
- Praise cards can be used to reset behaviour reflection time

Reports

- Daily, weekly, termly, or annual attendance percentages
- Detailed breakdown of each student's present, late, and absent records
- We include reasons and coded absences (e.g., illness, unauthorised holiday)
- End of month reports to monitor progression and assessments

Attendance Information for Referrers

- Attendance is taken for both morning and afternoon sessions
- 🔀 Daily absence calls are made, and reasons are recorded
- O Download daily reports to track reasons for absences
- Real-time attendance tracking to flag potential welfare issues

Safeguarding

- Secure access using password-protected meeting links or unique logins for each session to prevent unauthorised access.
- Daily attendance monitored, data accessible to referral agencies via weblink & app.
- Safe and well checks are conducted on vulnerable students to ensure regular attendance is made.
- Home visits are carried out on those who miss their lessons for 2 consecutive days.
- Unsuccessful home visits result in referrals being made to children missing in education.
